**TENNIS TIP
 Rattle the Net-Rusher**

Net Rushers can keep you on your heels, make you tense, and - there's no other way to say it - embarrass you on the tennis court. If an attacking player is on his or her game and you're not, a match can end before you break a sweat.

Your first job is to prevent, at all costs, the attacker from finding a rhythm. It starts on your return of serve. Don't return from the same position every time. You need to give the attacker different looks. Move into the court. Move back. Hedge toward your forehand, or if it's your better half, your backhand. Make the attacker pay attention to you. You might throw off his serve or cause him to reconsider the serve and volley.
