## DEAR 2009 SEASON PASS HOLDERS:

Thank you for purchasing a season pass to the Winnetka Park District Beaches for the 2009 season. There are a few things that staff would like to make you aware of this season.

### Safety

Please be advised that there is a drop off at Tower Road Beach approximately 10 feet from the shoreline. This drop off at the deepest point is about 6.5 feet deep. Please advise children who are not strong swimmers that the water gets deep very quickly and stay within an arms length of children you are at the beaches with.

### Deep Water

At all three Winnetka swimming beaches the water depths have increased in 2009. In some spots there is approximately a foot and a half difference in water depth. Please use caution when coming to the beach for the first time this summer, especially with smaller children and children that are not strong swimmers.

If you need anything at the lakefront or notice something that doesn't seem right please ask staff for help or make them aware of the situation.

### Cleanliness

Staff will be doing beach sweeps at every beach with garbage bags to clean up the beaches. If you have any garbage that needs to be thrown away, don't hesitate to give the lifeguards the garbage and they will gladly throw it away for you.

Thank you for your cooperation in these two areas, and staff looks forward to providing you with a great lakefront experience.

# BEACH RULES FOR 2009

- **WHEN LIFEGUARD IS NOT ON DUTY, SWIMMING IS AT YOUR OWN RISK.**
- Hours of operation are 9 a.m. to 7 p.m.
- Parents and guardians are responsible for the supervision of children.
- **DO NOT JUMP OFF OF PIERS.**
- Swim only in the designated swimming areas.
- Pets are not allowed on any beach except for Centennial.
- No rough play at any time.
- No scuba or snorkeling equipment will be allowed.
- Inflatable objects or floatation devices are not allowed in the water.
- No glass containers or alcoholic beverages are allowed.
- Infants must wear swimming diapers or equivalent when standing in the water.
- No swimming during inclement weather.
- Rocks and sand cannot be thrown at the beach.

## CENTENNIAL PARK & DOG BEACH RULES & REGULATIONS

- Dogs must be leashed at all times while in the park.
- Dogs may be released from their leash only when they enter the fenced-in area leading to the beach.
- Only current pass holders and their dogs may enter the fenced-in area leading to the beach.
- There is a limit of two dogs per person at the beach at a time.
- Patrons must pick up all waste from their dogs in the park and beach.
- No glass containers are allowed in the park or beach.
- Swimming, sun bathing and picnicking are prohibited on the beach.
- Patrons must stay within the fenced area at all times.
- Food of any kind is prohibited in the beach area.
- Children under 10 must be accompanied by an adult.
- No dog known to be aggressive toward other dogs or people may enter the area.
