Dear Lloyd Beach Patron,

Welcome to the 2010 Sailing season! It is time to renew your boat/kayak rack for the summer of 2010. As a 2009 season boat rack member you will be given priority for reserving a rack for the 2010 season.

If you wish to remain in the same rack as last year, please fill out the enclosed registration form, along with your payment to the Winnetka Park District, 540 Hibbard Road Winnetka, IL 60093. You may also fax your application back with credit card payment to (847) 501-5779.

Again this year, your boat pass number will coincide with your boat rack number. We hope this will alleviate any confusion as to who belongs in which slip. The deadline for registering to remain in your same rack is April 10, 2010. After April 10, the racks will be available for new members. There are a number of people on a wait list for a rack at this time, so this deadline will be enforced.

If you are interested in switching your rack, we will try to accommodate switches as early as possible. However, if spots are not available right away, they may become available after April 10, if other patrons do not renew their rack.

WAIVER AND RELEASE OF ALL CLAIMS AND ASSUMPTION OF RISK
>>>>PLEASE READ CAREFULLY BEFORE SIGNING<<<<

I accept that boat storage permits are non transferable. Boats with proper permits affixed may be placed on the beach beginning April 17, 2010. I agree my boat will be removed from the beach or winter boat storage will be purchased no later than OCTOBER 31, 2010. I understand that if my boat is not removed by this date or winter storage purchased, I will forfeit future use of this space and the space will be returned to the lottery for distribution.

NO ASSUMPTION OF CARE, CUSTODY OR CONTROL BY PARK DISTRICT

Owner is storing the boat at Owner's own risk and understands and agrees that by permitting Owner to store the boat on Park District Property, the Park District is not assuming the care, custody or control of the boat. Further, this agreement is not intended to establish, create, or impose joint ownership, care, or control of the boat or any other personal property of the boat owner.

INSURANCE AND INDEMNIFICATION

Owner shall at its own expense obtain and maintain during the term of this agreement, marine/property coverage insuring the boat against loss or damage to the boat by reason of fire, theft, vandalism, collision or other casualty, in not less than the actual cash value of the boat with respect to total loss or damage to the boat.

The insurer for the Owner shall agree to waive all rights of subrogation against the Winnetka Park District, including its officers, officials, employees, volunteers and agents for losses arising from this Agreement.

Further, and to the fullest extent permitted by law, Owner shall protect, indemnify, save, defend and hold harmless the Winnetka Park District, including its officers, officials, volunteers, employees and agents (collectively, the "Park District"), from and against any and all liabilities, obligations, claims, damages, penalties, causes of action, costs and expenses (including reasonable attorney and paralegal fees), which the Park District may become obligated by reason of any accident, bodily injury, death of person, or loss of or damage to tangible property, arising indirectly or directly in connection with or under, or as a result of this agreement.

SECURITY AND SUPERVISION

The Winnetka Park District shall not be responsible for the security, supervision, or safeguarding of Owner's boat or other personal property at any time.

WAIVER AND RELEASE OF ALL CLAIMS AND ASSUMPTION OF RISK

Owner expressly assumes the risk and legal liability and waives and releases all claims for damages or loss which Owner might sustain as a result of any and all activities connected with and associated with this permit (including any and all damage to, destruction of, theft, or loss of Owner's boat/property).

Owner acknowledges that there are certain risks of damage to its property/boat and Owner voluntarily agrees to assume the full risk of any and all damages or loss, regardless of severity, that Owner may incur as a result of this permit and the storage of Owner's boat. Owner further agrees to waive and relinquish all claims Owner may have (or accrue to Owner) as a result of this permit and the storage of Owner's boat/property against the Winnetka Park District, including its officials, agents, volunteers and employees.

I hereby certify and attest that the permit applied for herein is for a boat which I (we) legally own. It will only be operated by me, or a member of my immediate family. I understand and agree that I am solely responsible for the supervision and operation of my boat *at all times*, and for any loss or injury arising out of the use or operation of this boat. I further agree and understand that all authorized and permitted boat users shall comply with all Park District Ordinances and abide by all rules and regulations set forth by the Winnetka Park District as posted on the Sailing Beach and in Lloyd Park.

OTHER

Please note that it is prohibited for a boat owner to charter or rent his boat. Additionally, if I am to sell the boat for which this permit has been purchased, the spot shall not be transferrable to the new owner.
