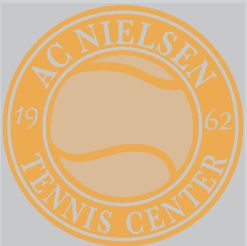

nielsen USTA PRO TENNIS CHAMPIONSHIP

The \$50,000 nielsen USTA Pro Tennis Championship is the third of seven summer hard court Challengers leading up to the 2011 US Open. The nielsen USTA Pro Tennis Championship celebrated its 20th year and its sixth consecutive year, while the Winnetka Park District has been a part of the USTA Pro Circuit since the mid-1980s. Past finalists in Winnetka include 14-time Grand Slam tournament champion Pete Sampras, who advanced to the doubles final with Jared Palmer in 1988. John Isner, Lleyton Hewitt, Todd Martin, Patrick Rafter and Sam Querrey also are veterans of the Winnetka Challenger. This year featured many highlights including the return of James Blake, who won the doubles title in 1999 with his brother Thomas and has been ranked as high as #3 in the world. Also, two-time Illinois State High School Champion and 2011 New Trier graduate Robert Stineman participated in the qualifier and partnered up with Thomas Blake in the doubles main draw. The stands were sold out for every evening match throughout the week. In the end James Blake defeated Bobby Reynolds 6-3, 6-1 to win the singles championship. Treat Huey and Bobby Reynolds defeated Jordan Kerr and Travis Parrott 7-6, 6-4 to win the doubles title.

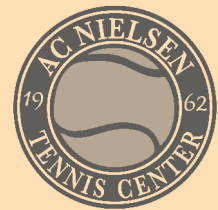

TENNIS TIP

Things to Consider When Using a Ball Machine

Do's . . .

- Place the ball machine off-center, where the opponent might be when making a shot.
- Have the ball machine direct shots where the opponent might hit based upon their position on the court or particular tendencies of a known opponent.
- If using the oscillation feature, have it direct the ball within the options available it were playing from that position in a rally.
- After each shot, the player should recover to a new position on the court based upon where they hit their return of the ball, then they should recover quickly based upon where the next ball is coming, from the ball machine.
- Direct each ball back toward an intended target, using direction, depth and spin.

Dont's . . .

- Do not place the ball machine only on the baseline in the center of the court.
- Do not have the ball machine oscillate only from deuce court to ad court.
- Do not use the ball machine to practice only ground strokes.
- Do not stand still after each shot.
- Do not return random shots of the incoming ball.
