

## **Registration and fees**

- The registration fee includes skater's costume, choreography and ice-time. Costumes are made to fit standard sizes; minimal alterations may be needed to compliment your skater. **Once costumes are ordered, no refunds or exchanges will be given.**
- In addition to the costume, fees will also include one parent badge that will serve as admittance to both shows, a program book an Ice Show t-shirt and a digital copy of the ice show to download.
- Registration forms, costume measurements and payment are due on or before Saturday, January 20<sup>th</sup>. Costume orders will not be processed until forms are completed and the fees are paid.
- \* Registrations will not be processed if skaters are not registered for both the Winter and Spring skating class sessions.

## Rehearsals

- The level of your skater's Winter Class on January 20<sup>th</sup> will determine the level in which they will be performing.
- Class time will not be used for rehearsals. Classes and rehearsals overlap for 4 weeks.
- Winnetka Figure Skating Club members enrolled in classes will perform an additional routine.
- All FS skaters will perform in the opening number in addition to their group number.
- All participants must attend a minimum of 3 of the 4 group rehearsals. Notify the skating director should you have a conflict of any kind. Additional requirements for Featured Skaters can be found on the Featured Skater registration form.

## **Tot Skaters**

Tot skaters will be performing in the first 20 minutes of the show. Once they are done with their performance, they must be picked up from the party room. They may go home or finish watching the show with their parents/guardians.

## **Picture Day**

Professional group and individual pictures will be taken on Saturday, April 6<sup>th</sup>. Costumes will be handed out the 1<sup>st</sup> week of rehearsals and must be worn to be in the group photo. These photos will be used in the Ice Show program. Have your skater ready to be photographed at their assigned time.

## **Dress Rehearsal**

Dress Rehearsal is mandatory for all skaters. Promptness is crucial for a smooth run-through. Allow enough time to put on costumes and skates. The finale will be rehearsed first so all skaters may stay and watch the show after performing their number.

## **Costumes & Measurements**

On Saturday, January 20<sup>th</sup> from 9-11am staff members will be available to assist you with registration and costume measurements. This is optional. Please allow room in your measurements for four months of growth for your child. An accurate girth measurement is crucial. Girth measurements are around the whole torso. Shoulder to shoulder. All Female skaters will receive a pair of suntan tights with their costumes to be worn for the show.

## **Featured Skaters**

Skaters who have qualified for duets, trios, one or two night solos will be provided with music. Soloist costumes and choreography are not provided. Duet and trio costumes and choreography will be provided. For more information regarding Featured Skater requirements, see Featured Skater form. Featured Skater's registration forms are due Thursday, January 26th.

#### **Rental Skates**

There is no charge for rental skates during the performances or rehearsals. Rental skates may be taken home for dress rehearsal. Skates may be signed out at the front desk by leaving your credit card number and contact info. You will be charged if they are not returned.

#### **Volunteers**

All performances need your help in making this show the absolute best. Please consider volunteering by checking the box on the registration form. You will be contacted in April for your availability. Your help is greatly appreciated by the skating school staff.
