Specialty Skater Information

Freestyle 1-4 Skaters

All Freestyle skaters enrolled in the winter and spring skating sessions are eligible to participate in a group number.

Freestyle skaters, who have passed Delta, are also eligible to be a “Specialty Skater” and perform a duet or trio in both shows in this year’s Ice Show.

Specialty Skater participation is not mandatory to perform with their group number.

- The Skating Director and staff will make duet and trio assignments.
- Costumes and music will be provided.
- A 45-minute rehearsal will be held on Monday, March 31 from 6:00 - 6:45pm, at which time skaters will learn their routines.
- Any additional lesson times can be arranged by the parents with a private lesson instructor.

Requirements

- Skaters must be registered in the Winter and Spring Session and attend at least 80% of the classes.
- Skaters missing more than one group rehearsal may not participate in any group or specialty skater numbers in the Ice Show.
- Skaters must perform in their group number in order to be a Specialty Skater.
