PARK TOUR MINUTES

Commissioners Mickey Archambault, Gerri Kahnweiler, Brad McLane, John Peterson and John Thomas, along with Executive Director, Robert Smith toured the Skokie Playfield Service Center, Crow Island Woods and Dwyer Park. The following residents also participated in the tour: Chris Crone, Marilyn Barter, Brit Barter and Jane Saccaro.

Skokie Playfield Service Center - 6:00 pm. Director Smith described the renovations that are scheduled to take place over the next few months. Discussion centered on the need to upgrade the facility to meet compliance with several regulatory requirements. Specifically, OSHA, ADA, MWRD and general building codes.

Crow Island Woods – 6:30 pm. Director Smith reviewed the site history of Crow Island Woods. Discussions included the possible use of areas of the park which might be used for Stormwater management. The tour proceeded with a walking tour to inspect existing condition of the woodland area.

Dwyer Park – 7:00 pm. Director Smith updated the tour group on the status of the master plan being developed for Dwyer Park. Mr. Smith reviewed details of the plan and the next steps in the planning process. Responding to a resident inquiry, Mr. Smith reviewed the standard planning process related to all major projects of the agency.
