Summary:

Please find attached a letter from Lisa Sheppard, Executive Director of the Glencoe Park District. This year, as last year, they are requesting resident access to swimming beaches run by the Winnetka Park District for the Fourth of July. This request was granted last year with the understanding that it would be reviewed on an annual basis. The impact under this agreement over the past two years was minimal with a total of less than 50 Glencoe residents split evenly between Maple and Elder Lane beaches.

Recommendation:

Based upon the use patterns of last year, staff recommends the Park Board approve the one day request with the provisions outlined in this request letter.

The Glencoe Park District Board once again made the decision to close Glencoe Beach on the Fourth of July in order to provide a fireworks display for the community. We would once again like to request the opportunity for those who would like to go to a beach, the prospect of doing so by sending patrons to Maple Street and Elder Lane Beaches.

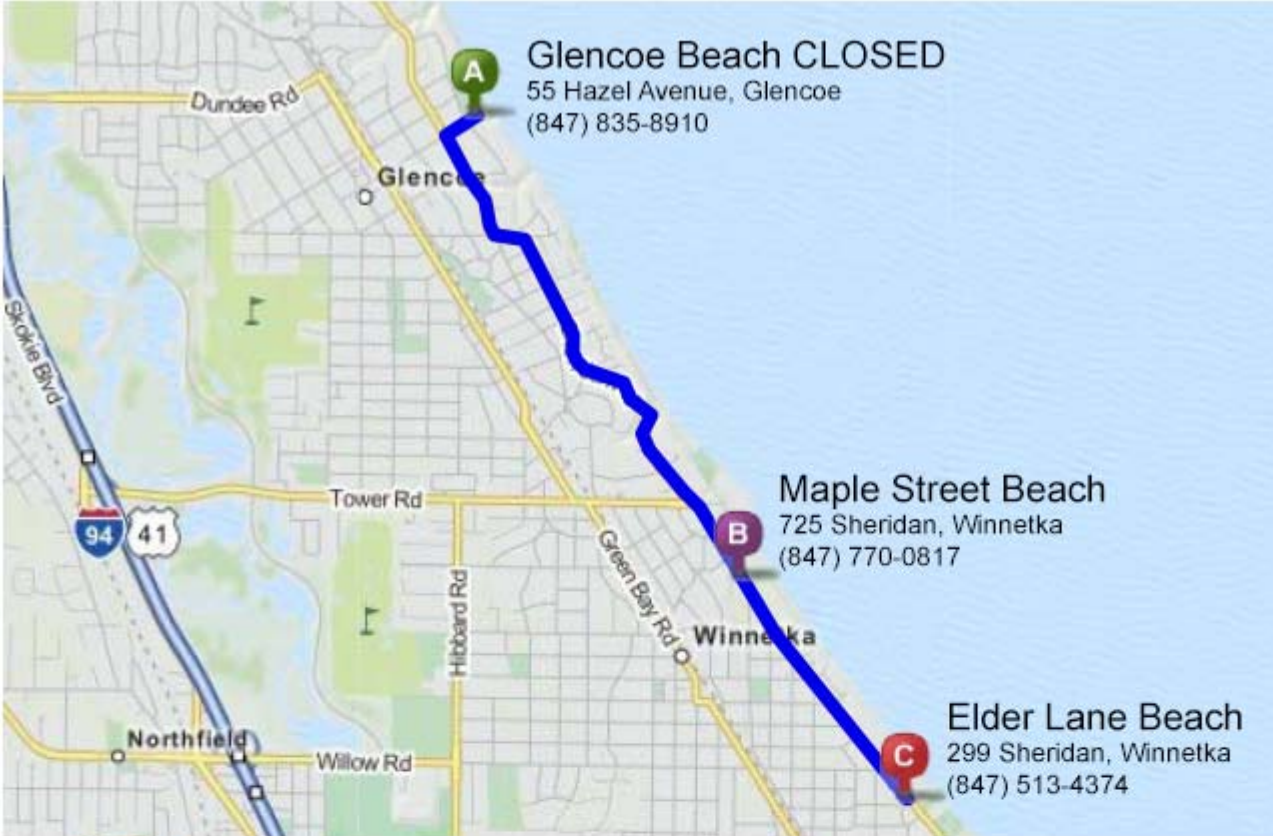
We are proposing the following options:

1. Send non-residents to Maple Street and Elder Lane Beach. They would pay your normal non-resident rates.
2. Send Glencoe resident users to Maple Street and Elder Lane Beach and they would pay your normal resident rates.
3. Send Glencoe Beach Token holders to Maple Street and Elder Lane Beach. They would be admitted free of charge; you would keep a tally of the token holders and bill the Glencoe Park District resident rates for their use that day.

I have also attached a flyer that we would hand out to patrons on the Fourth of July directing them to the beaches. While we hope this will help us accommodate the needs of beach goers on the Fourth of July, we would hope that your cooperation would be rewarded with increased revenue that day, given that a large amount of Glencoe Beach users on the Fourth of July have historically been daily fee non-residents.

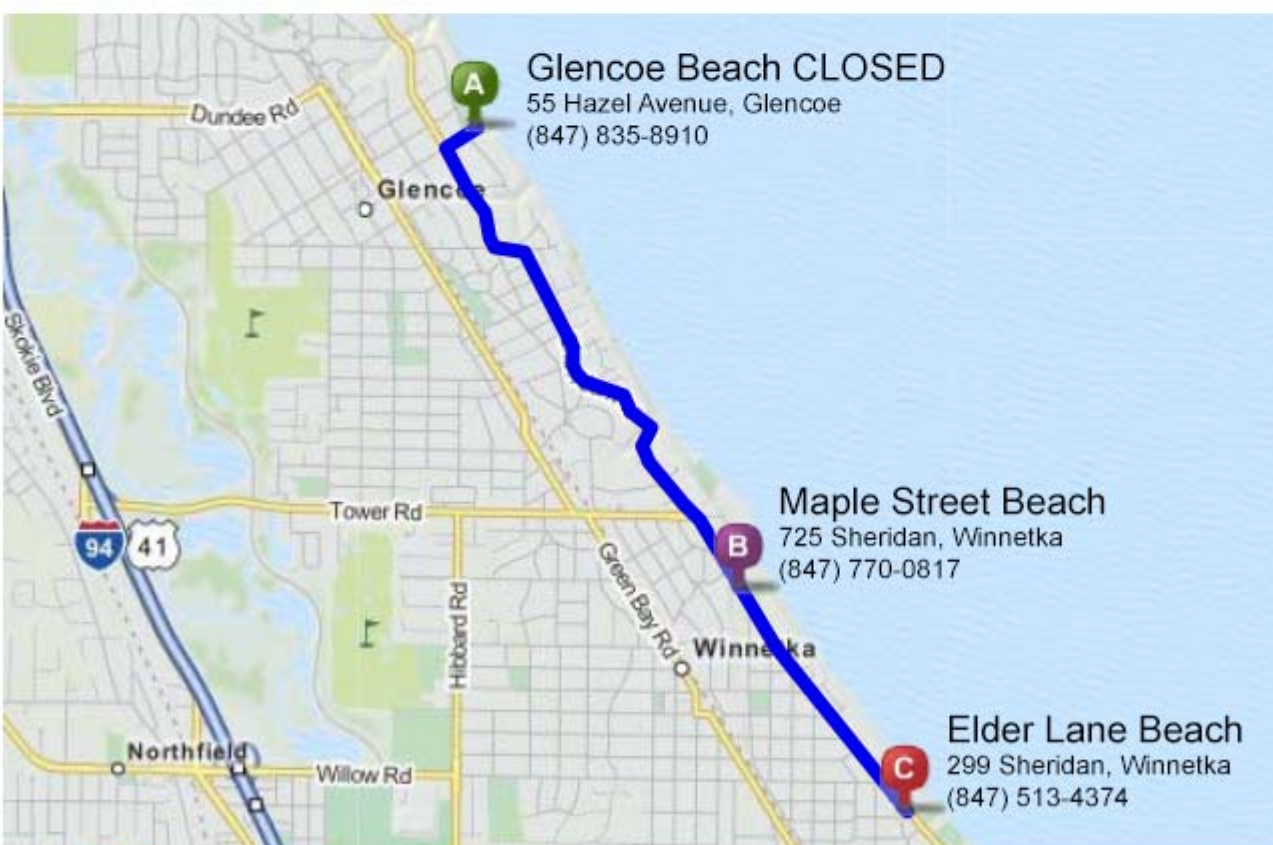
