### WINNETKA PARK DISTRICT

### ORDINANCE #577

ORDINANCE authorizing the issuance of General Obligation Park Bonds (Alternate Revenue Source) of the Winnetka Park District, Cook County, Illinois, in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$10,000,000 pursuant to the Local Government Debt Reform Act of the State of Illinois, as amended, for the payment of land condemned or purchased for parks, for the building, maintaining, improving and protecting of the same and the existing land and facilities of the District, including bluff improvements and shoreline stabilization under the Winnetka Waterfront 2030 Plan, and for the payment of the expenses incident thereto.

WHEREAS, the Winnetka Park District, Cook County, Illinois (the "District"), is a duly organized and existing park district created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois, and is now operating under the provisions of the Park District Code of the State of Illinois, as amended; and

WHEREAS, the Board has determined that it is advisable, necessary and in the best interests of the District to provide for the payment of land condemned or purchased for parks, for the building, maintaining, improving and protecting of the same and the existing land and facilities of the District, including bluff improvements and shoreline stabilization under the Winnetka Waterfront 2030 Plan, and for the payment of the expenses incident thereto (the "*Project*"), all in accordance with the preliminary estimate of cost heretofore approved by the Board and now on file in the office of the Secretary of the Board; and

WHEREAS, the Board has further determined the estimated cost of the Project, including legal, financial, bond discount, capitalized interest, printing and publication costs and other expenses, to be not less than \$10,000,000, and there are insufficient funds on hand and lawfully available to pay such costs; and

WHEREAS, the Board has further determined that it is advisable and necessary that the Project be undertaken and, in order to raise the funds required to pay such costs, that the District borrow an amount not to exceed \$10,000,000 and, in evidence thereof, issue General Obligation Park Bonds (Alternate Revenue Source) in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$10,000,000 (the "Bonds"), in accordance with the provisions of Section 15 of the Local Government Debt Reform Act of the State of Illinois, as amended; and

WHEREAS, the principal of and interest on the Bonds will be payable from proceeds received by the District from time to time from the issuance of its general obligation bonds or notes to the fullest extent permitted by law, including Section 6-4 of the Park Code, and Section 15.01 of the Local Government Debt Reform Act of the State of Illinois, as amended, and property taxes collected by the District for corporate and recreation purposes (the "*Pledged Revenues*"); and

WHEREAS, if the Pledged Revenues are insufficient to pay the Bonds, ad valorem property taxes upon all taxable property in the District without limitation as to rate or amount are authorized to be extended to pay the principal of and interest on the Bonds:

Now, Therefore, Be It and It Is Hereby Ordained by the Board of Park Commissioners of the Winnetka Park District, Cook County, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. Incorporation of Preambles. The Board hereby finds that all of the recitals contained in the preambles to this Ordinance are full, true and correct and does incorporate them into this Ordinance by this reference.

Section 2. Determination to Issue Bonds. It is necessary and in the best interests of the District to undertake the Project and the Bonds are hereby authorized to be issued and sold for that purpose.

Section 3. Publication. This Ordinance, together with a notice in the statutory form, shall be published in the Winnetka Talk, the same being a newspaper of general circulation in the

District, and if no petition, signed by 800 electors, the same being equal to the greater of (i) 7.5% of the number of registered voters in the District or (ii) 200 of those registered voters or 15% of those registered voters, whichever is less, asking that the issuance of the Bonds be submitted to referendum, is filed with the Secretary of the Board within thirty (30) days after the date of the publication of this Ordinance and said notice, then the Bonds shall be authorized to be issued.

Section 4. Additional Ordinances. If no petition meeting the requirements of applicable law is filed during the petition period hereinabove referred to, then the Board may adopt additional ordinances or proceedings supplementing or amending this Ordinance providing for the issuance and sale of the Bonds and prescribing all the details of the Bonds, so long as the maximum amount of the Bonds as set forth in this Ordinance is not exceeded and there is no material change in the Project or the purposes described herein. Such additional ordinances or proceedings shall in all instances become effective immediately without publication or posting or any further act or requirement. This Ordinance, together with such additional ordinances or proceedings, shall constitute complete authority for the issuance of the Bonds under applicable law.

Section 5. Severability. If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid or unenforceable, the invalidity or unenforceability of such section, paragraph, clause or provision shall not affect any of the other provisions of this Ordinance.

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Section 6. Repealer. All ordinances or orders, or parts thereof, in conflict herewith be and the same are hereby repealed, and that this Ordinance be in full force and effect forthwith upon its adoption.

### RESOLUTION 20-05-28-01

RESOLUTION calling a public hearing concerning the intent of the Board of Park Commissioners of the Winnetka Park District, Cook County, Illinois, to sell not to exceed \$10,000,000 General Obligation Park Bonds (Alternate Revenue Source).

WHEREAS, the Winnetka Park District, Cook County, Illinois (the "District"), is a duly organized and existing Park District created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois, and is now operating under the provisions of the Park District Code of the State of Illinois, and all laws amendatory thereof and supplementary thereto, including the Local Government Debt Reform Act of the State of Illinois, as amended; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Park Commissioners of the District (the "Board") intends to sell bonds in an amount not to exceed \$10,000,000 for the payment of land condemned or purchased for parks, for the building, maintaining, improving and protecting of the same and the existing land and facilities of the District, including bluff improvements and shoreline stabilization under the Winnetka Waterfront 2030 Plan, and for the payment of the expenses incident thereto (the "Bonds"); and

WHEREAS, the Bond Issue Notification Act of the State of Illinois, as amended, requires the Board to hold a public hearing concerning the Board's intent to sell the Bonds before adopting an ordinance providing for the sale of the Bonds:

Now, Therefore, Be It and It is Hereby Resolved by the Board of Park Commissioners of the Winnetka Park District, Cook County, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. Incorporation of Preambles. The Board hereby finds that all of the recitals contained in the preambles to this Resolution are full, true and correct and does incorporate them into this Resolution by reference.

Section 2. Public Hearing. The Board hereby calls a public hearing to be held at 6:00 o'clock P.M. on the 18th day of June, 2020, in the Administrative Office, 540 Hibbard Road, Winnetka, Illinois, in the District, concerning the Board's intent to sell the Bonds and to receive public comments regarding the proposal to sell the Bonds (the "Hearing").

Section 3. Notice. The Secretary of the Board (the "Secretary") shall (i) publish notice of the Hearing at least once in the Winnetka Talk, the same being a newspaper of general circulation in the District, not less than 7 nor more than 30 days before the date of the Hearing and (ii) post at least 48 hours before the Hearing a copy of said notice at the principal office of the Board, which notice will be continuously available for public review during the entire 48-hour period preceding the Hearing.

Section 4. Form of Notice. Notice of the Hearing shall appear above the name of the Secretary and shall be in substantially the following form:

PUBLIC NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Winnetka Park District, Cook County, Illinois (the "District"), will hold a public hearing on the 18th day of June, 2020, at 6:00 o'clock P.M. The hearing will be held in the Administrative Office, 540 Hibbard Road, Winnetka, Illinois. The purpose of the hearing will be to receive public comments on the proposal to sell bonds in an amount not to exceed \$10,000,000 for the payment of land condemned or purchased for parks, for the building, maintaining, improving and protecting of the same and the existing land and facilities of the District, including bluff improvements and shoreline stabilization under the Winnetka Waterfront 2030 Plan, and for the payment of the expenses incident thereto.

Section 5. Hearing Requirements. At the Hearing the Board shall explain the reasons for the proposed bond issue and permit persons desiring to be heard an opportunity to present written or oral testimony within reasonable time limits. The Board shall not adopt an ordinance selling the Bonds for a period of seven (7) days after the final adjournment of the Hearing.

Section 6. Severability. If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Resolution shall be held to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, the invalidity or unenforceability of such section, paragraph, clause or provision shall not affect any of the remaining provisions of this Resolution.

Section 7. Repeal. All resolutions and parts thereof in conflict herewith be and the same are hereby repealed, and this Resolution shall be in full force and effect forthwith upon its adoption.
