

Brick, Bench & Tree Donation Program Descriptions . . .

Brick Paver

The Brick Paver Program provides an opportunity for you to create a lasting impression at Centennial Park. Each brick is engraved and can be personalized to honor or memorize people or family pets.

Cost Per Brick: \$100

Bench

Provide respite at one of our many parks with a refurbished and plaqued Bench.

Cost Per Bench: \$2500

Small Tree

Ornamental trees that remain under 25 feet tall, including flowering crabapples, redbud, serviceberry, hawthorn, flowering dogwood, river birch, and fringe trees.

Cost Per Tree: \$750

Large Tree

Large shade trees, including swamp white oak, bur oak, red oak, sugar maple, red maple, green ash, honey locust, American beech, green spruce, red pine, and white pine.

Cost Per Tree: \$1250

We will make every effort to honor your location request, within certain park perimeters. All brick, bench and tree locations require final consent of the Superintendent of Parks.
